Status report

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18 Counsel files this status report to inform the Court that Mr. Singh is
19 currently detained at the California City Corrections Center in the Eastern District
20 of California, and that counsel has not yet communicated with him regarding his
21 petition and upcoming bond hearing.

22 Counsel had a legal call scheduled with Mr. Singh this morning at the Otay
23 Mesa Detention Center. At the time of that call, counsel was told by Otay Mesa
24 Detention Center staff that Mr. Singh had been transferred out of the facility.

25 Since then, Respondents have reviewed records and counsel for
26 Respondents has informed Petitioners' counsel that Mr. Singh was moved from
27 the Otay Mesa Detention Center on February 22, 2026, to the California City
28 Corrections Center, where he is currently held.

1 Mr. Singh had placed his habeas petition in the mailbox on February 9,
2 2026, while he was detained at the Otay Mesa Detention Center. *See* ECF No. 1 at
3 9. This Court thus has jurisdiction under the mailbox rule. *See Hernandez v.*
4 *Spearman*, 764 F.3d 1071, 1074 (9th Cir. 2014) (explaining the prison mailbox
5 rule in *pro se* habeas litigation).

6 However, this Court did not receive his petition until March 2. *See* ECF No.
7 1 at 10. By that time, according to Respondents' records, Mr. Singh had been
8 transferred out of district. He has remained at the California City Correctional
9 Center.

10 On March 6, this Court issued the following order: "[T]he Respondents are
11 enjoined from removing the Petitioner from the Southern District of California
12 until the petition is decided." ECF No. 3 at 2.

13 Counsel is working to set up a legal call with Mr. Singh as soon as possible
14 at the California City Corrections Center. It appears the earliest available call is
15 on this Thursday, March 26.
