

MASTER PACKET – EMERGENCY PETITION FOR WRIT OF HABEAS CORPUS

IMPORTANT CLARIFICATION: All photographs included in this packet document **prior surgical treatment in Cuba**. They are submitted solely to demonstrate the chronic, serious, and life-threatening nature of the Petitioner's medical condition and **do not represent his current physical condition**.

I. Emergency Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus (28 U.S.C. § 2241)

This Emergency Petition is submitted to the United States District Court for the Southern District of Florida requesting the **immediate release** of the Petitioner from ICE custody. Continued detention places the Petitioner at substantial risk of serious injury or death due to a severe and chronic medical condition.

Civil immigration detention is administrative, not punitive. When detention threatens life or health, continued confinement violates the **Due Process Clause of the Fifth Amendment**.

II. Severe and Life-Threatening Medical Condition

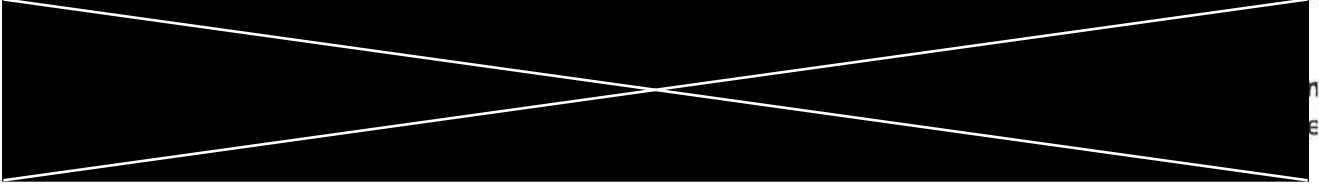
The Petitioner suffers from **acute ulcerative colitis**, a serious inflammatory bowel disease that is currently severe and aggravated. The disease has caused extensive recto-anal damage, including sphincter injury and multiple fistulas.

Due to this condition, the Petitioner experiences loss of bowel control, involuntary evacuation, inability to evacuate at times, and continuous discharge of gas and bodily fluids. Strict hygiene and medical supervision are medically necessary.

Any obstruction of drainage or lack of hygiene places the Petitioner at immediate risk of **peritonitis**, a life-threatening infection that can rapidly lead to sepsis and death.

III. Medical History and Prior Surgical Treatment

Prior to arriving in the United States, the Petitioner underwent surgical treatment in **Cuba** related to his ulcerative colitis and recto-anal complications. Unfortunately, these surgeries **did not heal properly** due to the



Photographs from these surgeries are attached as **Exhibit A** to demonstrate the seriousness of the condition and the failure of proper healing caused by his illness.

After arriving in Florida, the Petitioner sought emergency medical care at **Physicians Regional – Collier Boulevard** in Naples, Florida, where diagnostic testing was performed and referral to a recto-anal specialist was made.

IV. Affidavit and Humanitarian Statement of Spouse

I, **Arletty Pinero**, am the lawful wife of Adriel Ramon Mesa Rodriguez. My husband is a young, calm, and peaceful man. He is not a danger to the community and not a flight risk.

Our entire family holds hope that with freedom, proper hygiene, and specialized medical care, his condition can stabilize and improve. Continued detention places his life at risk and causes severe emotional suffering to our family.

I respectfully ask this Honorable Court to order my husband's **immediate release** so that his life may be preserved and he may receive proper medical care.
