SUPPLEMENTAL (THIRD)

Pursuant to the Court's May 7, 2026, order, Respondent provide this update on the Petitioner's custodial status. Petitioner posted a \$500 bond as part of his initial acceptance of the grant of voluntary return to Mexico by the immigration judge. Instead of complying with the requirements of the voluntary return order, Petitioner appealed the order to the Board of Immigration Appeals on April 20, 2026. As a result of the filing of the appeal, the voluntary return order converted to an order of removal to Mexico. Due to a miscommunication, the undersigned believed that Petitioner had been released to execute the voluntary return order after posting the bond as normally occurs with the voluntary return process. Petitioner, in fact, had not yet been released

1 because he had reserved appeal of the immigration judge's grant of voluntary return
2 rather than cooperated with ICE ERO to execute his removal to Mexico. As a result,
3 he remains detained. Undersigned counsel apologizes to the Court for the error.
