NOTICE OF RIPENESS AND MOTION TO EXPEDITE RULING

Petitioner, Jorge S. Perez-Marrero, by and through undersigned counsel, respectfully notifies this Court that the Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus is fully briefed and ripe for adjudication, and respectfully moves this Court to expedite its ruling. In support, Petitioner states as follows:

I. NOTICE OF RIPENESS

The parties have completed briefing in this matter. Petitioner filed his Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2241.

Respondents filed their Opposition, and Petitioner filed a Reply addressing those arguments.

The matter is therefore fully briefed and ripe for determination.

II. MOTION TO EXPEDITE RULING

This case concerns Petitioner's continued civil immigration detention. Petitioner has remained in custody since October 26, 2025.

As set forth in the pleadings, Respondents have not demonstrated that removal is reasonably foreseeable, nor have they identified any material change in circumstances that would justify Petitioner's re-detention after nearly a decade of compliance under an Order of Supervision.

The issues before the Court are fully briefed and do not require further factual development. Continued detention during the pendency of this matter results in ongoing deprivation of liberty.

Petitioner also suffers from serious medical and mental health conditions, including schizophrenia and hypertension, which require consistent care and are adversely affected by continued detention.

Under these circumstances, Petitioner respectfully requests that the Court consider the Petition on an expedited basis.

III. CONCLUSION

Petitioner respectfully requests that this Court:

1. Recognize that the Petition is fully briefed and ripe for adjudication; and
2. Expedite its ruling on the Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus.
