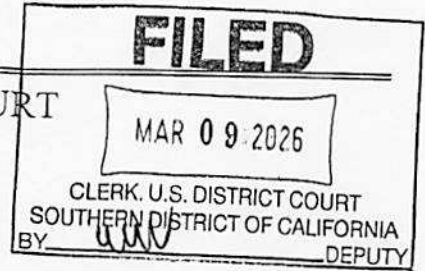

GROUND ONE: My prolonged and continuous confinement for more than 10 months violates the fifth amendment rights of the United States Constitution, Law and Treaties.

I entered the U.S on 15/04/2025 around the Tecate border and was apprehended by border patrol agents. Being in ICE custody, I have had a positive CAT asylum interview. I filed for Asylum and still in my removal proceedings. I have not been given an opportunity for an individualised bond hearing.

GROUND TWO: The likelihood of my future detention duration is unknown and may take several more months or even years.

During my confinement, my court date has been changed several times. Firstly, ICE served my NTA later than the date on the notice. Secondly, my judge has been changed twice. Every new judge gives a new master hearing. The last who scheduled my individual hearing on 20/05/2026 has also been changed so might take longer.
