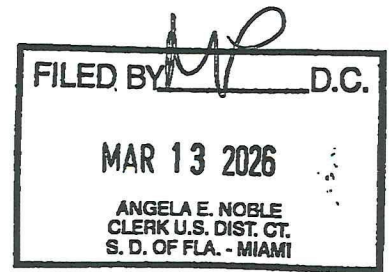

EMERGENCY MOTION FOR TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER

Petitioner, Amaury Perez-Vega, appearing *pro se*, respectfully moves this Court for a Temporary Restraining Order (TRO) pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 65(b).

1. Immediate Harm: Petitioner has a mandatory biometrics appointment on May 09, 2025, at 03:00 PM. Failure to appear will result in USCIS treating his I-485 application as abandoned, leading to an immediate and irreparable denial of his legal path to residency.
2. Likelihood of Success: Petitioner is a native of Cuba with a credible fear of persecution. He has a valid, pending adjustment-of-status application (Receipt IOE0931261248).
3. Balance of Equities: The harm to Petitioner (loss of legal status and potential removal) outweighs any administrative burden on the Respondents.
4. Public Interest: It is in the public interest to ensure that individuals are not deprived of their due process rights when seeking legal status through established channels.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner requests that this Court issue a TRO enjoining Respondents from removing Petitioner from the jurisdiction or allowing his immigration benefits to lapse due to his detention.
