OPPOSITION TO MOTION TO ENFORCE

The Federal Respondents oppose Petitioner's motion to enforce. Petitioner was served on March 31, 2026, with notice of his scheduled bond hearing. *See* Ex. 1. The written notice informs Petitioner that his bond hearing was scheduled for April 8, 2026. *Id.* Petitioner received a bond hearing as directed by this Court on April 9, 2026. Ex. 2. Undersigned counsel is not aware of why the notice was for a hearing on April 8, 2026, while the bond hearing itself was on April 9, 2026, but points out that difference for the Court.

Undersigned counsel has requested proof of service of the Court's order on Defendant, if any, but has not yet received it. Should counsel receive that before the Court rules on this motion, counsel will file that with the Court.

WHEREFORE, the Federal Respondents respectfully request that this Court deny Giron Camargo's Motion to Enforce.
