SECOND MOTION TO
ENFORCE COURT ORDER
AND REQUEST FOR RELEASE

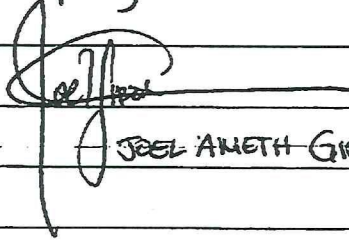
I, Joel Ameth Giron Camargo, petitioner in this habeas action, appearing pro se, respectfully submitting this motion to enforce this court Opinion and Order. (Doc. 17)

This Court Ordered the Respondents to afford the Petitioner with a second bond hearing with guardrails within ten (10) days from June 11, 2026. Such hearing must include and reflect consideration of evidence and factors announced in *re Guerra*, 24 I & N. Dec. 37 (BIA 2006), where the government must bear the burden of proof, and Petitioner must be given at least 48 hour "Notice to Appear"; if government were not unable to comply with the terms of the order, Petitioner must be released. The Government has failed to comply with the requirements that satisfy the court order, so this court should grant this request for release ordering Respondents to immediately release Joel Ameth Giron Camargo from custody.

Petitioner respectfully requests the court to declare his detention unconstitutional and such other relief as the court deems just and appropriate.
