**FEDERAL RESPONDENTS' RESPONSE TO ORDER FOR STATUS
UPDATE**

Petitioner Yezid Shabana has filed a motion to reopen and for a temporary restraining order on the grounds that although he was released as previously ordered, he was redetained three days later. (Doc. 12; Doc. 13). Shaban also filed by mail a pro se Motion to Enforce Judgment. (Doc. 18). Previously, this Court ordered Federal Respondent's to "identify in detail all actions taken by ICE subsequent to Shabana's ordered release to ensure his imminent removal and shall provide the name of the official who ordered Shabana's re-arrest". (Doc. 16 at 1 and 2). As this court ordered, only if no substantial actions have been taken or ICE's actions were merely performative, will Federal Respondent's be required to respond to the motion for a temporary restraining order. (*Id.* at 2). Federal Respondent's filed a response to this Courts ordered explaining that Shabana's removal was imminent. (Doc. 17). This

Court ordered a status update regarding Shabana's current location. (Doc. 19). Federal Respondent's now file this status update to inform the Court that Shabana was released by way of removal on June 9, 2026. (Ex. 1, Detention History, Accurate as of June 17, 2026). Additionally, the undersigned spoke with Petitioner's counsel via email on June 16, 2026, to inform counsel of the status and this intended filing, and counsel advised he was aware that Petitioner has been removed to Palestine.

Should The Court require more information, Federal Respondent's stand ready to provide whatever information is available.
