1           In its return, the government concedes that because it is “unable to ascertain  
2 sufficient facts at this time to establish that there is a significant likelihood of  
3 removal in the reasonably foreseeable future,” Mr. Gadri is “entitled to be  
4 released from custody subject to conditions of supervision.” Dkt. 7 at 1. Mr. Gadri  
5 thus requests that this Court immediately grant his habeas petition and order him  
6 released.
