ORDER OF THE IMMIGRATION JUDGE

The respondent requested a custody redetermination pursuant to 8 C.F.R. § 1236. After full consideration of the evidence presented, the respondent's request for a change in custody status is hereby ordered:

Denied, because

Granted. It is ordered that Respondent be:

- released from custody on his own recognizance.
- released from custody under bond of \$ 3,500.00
- other:

Alternatives to Detention (ATD) such as electronic monitoring may be imposed at DHS discretion;

Respondent must not commit any criminal, local, state, federal or immigration law, including working without authorization or driving without a driver license;

Respondent must live with her sponsors



If Respondent wishes to relocate, he must obtain written permission from DHS/ICE before moving to a new location; Additionally, Respondent must file an EOIR-33 address change notification (blue form) with the court within 5 days of moving;

Failure to Appear Warnings: If you fail to appear for any hearings and there are no exceptional circumstances which caused your absence, a hearing may be held in your absence and an order of removal may be entered against you and all relief applications deemed abandoned.

Counsel will ensure that Respondent complies with all conditions of release.
