RESPONSE TO PETITION

21 Petitioner appears to be a member of the Bond Eligible Class certified in *Maldonado*
22 *Bautista v. Santacruz*, No. 5:25-CV-01873-SSS-BFM, --- F. Supp. 3d ---, 2025 WL
23 3288403 (C.D. Cal. Nov. 25, 2025). The Ninth Circuit later stayed application of the Order
24 beyond the Central District of California. However, Respondents acknowledge the prior
25 orders from this District directing bond hearings pursuant to 8 U.S.C. § 1226(a) in similar
26 cases.¹

28 ¹ To the extent the Court issues an order directing a bond hearing under 1226(a),

1 Here, the Petitioner has lived continuously in this country for potentially several
2 decades without admission or inspection, nor having a bond hearing. However,
3 Respondents are informed and believe Petitioner was convicted of petty theft in 1986 and
4 was more recently arrested for a serious felony, oral copulation with a minor under 10 years
5 old. Petitioner's felony case is still pending in San Bernardino County.² For these reasons,
6 Respondents respectfully request this Court order a bond hearing to be held pursuant to 8
7 U.S.C. § 1226(a), so that an Immigration Judge can determine Petitioner's potential flight
8 risk and/or danger to the community.
