ABBREVIATED RESPONSE TO PETITION

On April 30, 2026, the Court received Petitioner's recast application for habeas corpus relief under 28 U.S.C. § 2241. ECF No. 1. On the same day, the Court ordered Respondents to file a comprehensive response to said application within twenty-one (21) days. ECF No. 6. Because of the Eleventh Circuit's ruling in *Hernandez Alvarez v. Warden, Fed. Det. Ctr. Miami*, No. 25-14065, 2026 WL 1243395 (11th Cir. May 6, 2026), Petitioner is entitled to a bond hearing under 8 U.S.C. § 1226(a) if the Court finds that he is a non-citizen arrested in the interior of the United States and is not seeking admission.
