1 Petitioner appears to be a member of the Bond Eligible Class certified in  
2 *Maldonado Bautista v. Santacruz*, No. 5:25-CV-01873-SSS-BFM, --- F. Supp. 3d ---,  
3 2025 WL 3288403 (C.D. Cal. Nov. 25, 2025). The Ninth Circuit later stayed application  
4 of the Order beyond the Central District of California. However, Respondents  
5 acknowledges the prior orders from this District directing bond hearings pursuant to 8  
6 U.S.C. § 1226(a) in similar cases.<sup>1</sup> Respondents therefore do not oppose an order from  
7 this Court directing a bond hearing be held pursuant to 8 U.S.C. § 1226(a).
