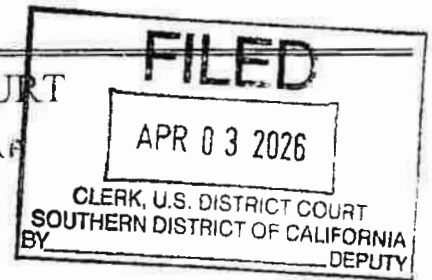

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**DECLARATION OF MY STAY IN OTAY MESA DETENTION CENTER SAN
DIEGO, CALIFORNIA**

I ENTERED THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA ON **DECEMBER 2018** WITH MY MUM AT THE AGE OF 15 . I WAS APREHENDED BY THE BORDER PATROL AGENTS AND TAKEN INTO DHS CUSTODY ON THE VERY SAME DAY. I WAS THEN **RELEASED ON PAROLE** BY THE DISCRETION OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL ON **DECEMBER 2024**.

MY IMMIGRATION CASE IS CURRENTLY **PENDING** BEFORE AN IMMIGRATION JUDGE. I HAVE NEVER BEING GIVEN A CUSTODY REDETERMINATION HEARING BY THE GOVERNMENT WHERE THEY BEAR THE BURDEN TO PROVE THAT MY CONTINUED DETENTION IS NECESSARY. I WAS **ARRESTED ILLEGALLY** AS I HAVE NOT BROKEN ANY CONDITIONS PERTAINING TO MY PAROLE.

I STILL DO NOT KNOW WHY I WAS ARRESTED. I WAS GOING TO PICK UP MY FIANCE AT A MILITARY BASE IN OCEASIDE, SAN DIEGO,CA. I DID NOT KNOW IT WAS A TARGET PLACE FOR IMMIGRANT DRIVERS. AFTER I GOT TO THE MILITARY BASE THEY ASKED FOR MY IDENTIFICATION AND I SHOWED THEM MY DRIVER'S LICENSE AS SOON AS THEY DISCOVERED I'M NOT A US CITIZEN THEY CONTACTED **ICE** AND I WAS TAKEN INTO DHS CUSTODY ON **FEBRUARY 21, 2026**.

I AM CURRENTLY PETITIONING WITH THE USCIS TO GET MARRIED TO MY AMERICA CITIZEN FIANCE, I HAVE **NO CRIMINAL BACKGROUND**. MY CURRENT CONDITION OF MY HEALTH IS REALLY **TERRIBLE**, AND UNBEARABLE. I AM SUFFERING FROM **LACK OF SLEEP, GENERAL MALAISE**,

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ANXIETY, PTSD AND DEPRESSION. PRIOR TO MY RE-ARREST BY ICE I DID NOT HAVE THIS SYMPTOM CLUSTER. MY PHYSICAL HEALTH AND MENTAL HEALTH IS SLOWLY DEPRECIATING EVERY SINGLE DAY I SPEND IN THIS PLACE.

I AM APPLYING FOR HABEAS CORPUS AND TO THE HIGHER AUTHORITY TO IMMEDIATELY RELEASE ME FROM DETENTION OR IN ALTERNATIVE ORDER RESPONDENTS TO GIVE ME A BOND HEARING BEFORE NEUTRAL GROUNDS. IF GRANTED IT WILL GIVE ME A CHANCE TO CONTINUE TO FIGHT MY CASE OUTSIDE DETENTION IN FREEDOM AND GOOD HEALTH CONDITIONS.
