**DECLARATION OF
LIZBETH BRIBIESCA**

I, Lizbeth Bribiesca, declare the following under 28 U.S.C. § 1746, and state that under the penalty of perjury, the following is true and correct to the best of my knowledge and belief:

1 1. I am a Deportation Officer (DO) with the U.S. Department of
2 Homeland Security (DHS), Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE),
3 Enforcement and Removal Operations (ERO), in the Calexico, California suboffice
4 of the San Diego Field Office. I have been employed by ICE as a law enforcement
5 officer since December 15, 2002 and have been serving as a DO since June 28, 2015.
6 My responsibilities include case management of individuals detained at the San Luis
7 Regional Detention Facility (SLRDF) in San Luis, Arizona.

8 2. I have access to the official files and records of DHS.

9 3. I have reviewed official files and records maintained by DHS relating
10 to Petitioner Hong Ge 

11 4. The following information is based on my personal knowledge, as well
12 as my review of government databases and documentation relating to the Petitioner.

13 5. Petitioner is a native and citizen of China.

14 6. This declaration is provided as a supplement to the previously provided
15 declaration.

16 7. Petitioner's counsel filed a Habeas Petition in the United States District
17 Court, District of Arizona with case number 26-cv-2395-MJM-MTM for a different
18 Petitioner, TingTing Gao, but utilized the alien registration number of Hong Ge in
19 that Habeas Petition. The wrong A# caused the Habeas Petition for TingTing Gao
20 to be uploaded to Hong Ge's case file. The case heading and case number from
21 TingTing Gao was then mistakenly used for the previously submitted declaration.

22 8. All information from the previous declaration remains accurate
23 regarding Petitioner Hong Ge, and follows below. The only change made in this
24 supplemental declaration is to the case heading and case number above.

25 9. On April 30, 2025, Petitioner was taken into ICE custody and served
26 with a Notice and Order of Expedited Removal. Petitioner did not claim fear of
27 return to China.
