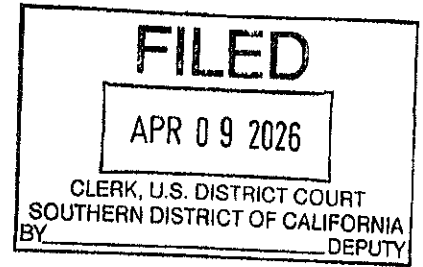

**MOTION FOR TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER,
AND
INJUNCTIVE RELIEF**

TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER

Petitioner-Plaintiff, Ancelmo Carrillo-Carrillo moves this court *ex parte* for a Temporary Restraining Order that would, among other things, require his immediate release from his ongoing detention by agents of Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) and prohibit his re-arrest without pre-detention hearing before an "IJ" Immigration judge at which ICE establishes by clear and convincing evidence that his detention is necessary to prevent his Flight Risk or Protect the Public.


Background:

The evidence before this Court establishes that Ancelmo Carrillo-Carrillo is a 35-year old from Guatemala. Petitioner came into the United States for a better future and life. Petitioner is fleeing the Guatemalan corruption and the Cartels Violence which President Donald J. Trump has signaled them as Terrorist. Here Petitioner entered the United States on 3-26-2026 seeking a better future and life, plus fleeing persecution by the cartels. Petitioner has been previously removed from the United States illegally by ICE on TWO occasions since Petitioner has a 9th Circuit Court of Appeals case by No. 22-861 pending. Petitioner has lived in the United States prior to the unlawful deportations Petitioner has suffered in the hands of ICE. Petitioner has his own construction company and has 4 U.S.C children of ages 5,10,14,16 who depend on his father to pay school,rent, and food. Here it is clear that Petitioner's Due Process Right has been violated on TWO occasions by the ICE Agency for deporting Petitioner to his home country of Guatemala when in fact Petitioner had a pending 9th Circuit Court of Appeals case with an Emergency Stay of Removal in place. The first time Petitioner was deported unjustly was on year 2022 and again on February 2026. ICE Officer M. Parsons is who handled my last

deportation on 2-17-2026 he responded to a Talton message I sent him: I can't give you an exact date but you have been scheduled for the end of this month. Here Petitioner's 9th Circuit Court of Appeals case is under review from an Asylum case were Petitioner expresses fear of returning back to his country. Even so, ICE has on **TWO** occasions deported Petitioner to his country placing Petitioner's life in grave danger and it is why Petitioner has returned. Here is clear that Petitioner's 14th Amendment of the U.S. Constitution has been violated. Petitioner request that this Court grant the Temporary Restraining Order so Respondent's cannot transfer Petitioner out of the Jurisdiction of the Court or from the Otay Mesa Detention Center until the Habeas Corpus is adjudicated. My health has worsen because I have developed Depression, Anxiety, and Major Stress Disorder because of the prolonged period of detention I have spent in custody and not being able to be by the side of my immediate family. I have not received any incident reports for misbehavior since I have been detained here at Otay Mesa Detention Center and have remained in good behavior while in ICE custody. I am requesting for this Temporary Restraining Order to be put in place so ICE won't be able to transfer me or deport me before this Habeas Corpus is adjudicated. I have kept a job in this detention center and have attended courses to better myself in life and I continue to work on myself.
