21 Based upon the allegations set forth in the Petition, Petitioner appears to be a member
22 of the Bond Eligible Class certified in *Maldonado Bautista v. Santacruz*, No. 5:25-CV-
23 01873-SSS-BFM, --- F. Supp. 3d ---, 2025 WL 3288403 (C.D. Cal. Nov. 25, 2025). The
24 Ninth Circuit later stayed application of the Order beyond the Central District of California.
25 However, Respondents acknowledges prior orders from this District directing bond
26 hearings pursuant to 8 U.S.C. § 1226(a) in similar cases.¹ *See, e.g., Trujillo v. Noem*, No.
