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20 **I. INTRODUCTION**

21 Pursuant to the Court's order dated May 13, 2026, Respondents provide the
22 following information.

23 After five delay requests by the Petitioner to obtain counsel and to prepare his
24 claims resulting in about six months of delay, a merits hearing was set for May 5,
25 2026, but then vacated and reset as a master calendar hearing on April 28, 2026, for
26 the purpose of allowing Petitioner more time to gather evidence. On April 28, 2026,
27 the final merits hearing was set for May 26, 2026. ECF No. 4 at Ex. 3 (Event History);
28 ECF No. 4 at Ex. 4 (Adjournment Codes). Petitioner's removal proceedings remain

1 pending. The Petitioner has the option to file an appeal of any removal order or other
2 denial or relief to the Board of Immigration Appeals.
