**PETITIONER'S
STATUS REPORT**

Petitioner, JAIDIVERT HURTADO-ANCHICO, through counsel, respectfully requests a status report on the Writ of Habeas Corpus filed on April 20, 2026. [See Dkt. No.: 1].

This Court may grant relief under the Habeas Corpus statutes, 28 U.S.C. § 2241 et. seq., The Declaratory Judgment Act, 28 U.S.C. § 2201 et. seq., and the All-Writs

Act, 28 U.S.C. § 1651 alleging unlawful immigration detention and requesting immediate release, or in the alternative, a bond hearing. Petitioner has remained in continuous immigration custody since February 27, 2026, and as of the filing of this status request, remains detained at the Otay Mesa Detention Center in San Diego, CA.

The Respondents filed a Return to the Petition for Writ Habeas Corpus on April 28, 2026. [See Dkt. No.: 4]. The Respondents state that, after reviewing the Petition for a Writ of Habeas Corpus, they do not oppose the Petition and defer to the Court on the appropriate relief. Respondents also request, in the event the Court orders a bond hearing, that the government be afforded 14 days to conduct such hearing. [Id.].

In light of Respondents' non-opposition, and the ongoing deprivation of liberty, the Petitioner respectfully moves this Court to issue an order demanding the immediate release of the Petitioner from his prolonged detention at the Otay Mesa Correctional Facility. This Court may grant relief under the Habeas Corpus statutes, 28 U.S.C. § 2241 et. seq., The Declaratory Judgment Act, 28 U.S.C. § 2201 et. seq., and the All-Writs Act, 28 U.S.C. § 1651 alleging unlawful immigration detention and requesting immediate release, or in the alternative, a bond hearing within fourteen (14) days.
