**RETURN TO PETITION FOR WRIT
OF HABEAS CORPUS**

1 Petitioner appears to be a member of the Bond Eligible Class certified in *Maldonado*
2 *Bautista v. Santacruz*, No. 5:25-CV-01873-SSS-BFM, --- F. Supp. 3d ---, 2025 WL
3 3288403 (C.D. Cal. Nov. 25, 2025). The Ninth Circuit later stayed application of the Order
4 beyond the Central District of California. However, Respondents acknowledges the prior
5 orders from this District directing bond hearings pursuant to 8 U.S.C. § 1226(a) in similar
6 cases.¹

7 Respondents therefore do not oppose an order from this Court directing a bond
8 hearing be held pursuant to 8 U.S.C. § 1226(a).
