PETITIONER'S NOTICE OF VOLUNTARY DISMISSAL

Pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(a)(1)(A)(i), Petitioner, Jose G. Encarnacion-Villafuerte, by and through his undersigned counsel, hereby gives notice of the voluntary dismissal of the above-captioned petition for a writ of habeas corpus, without prejudice.

In support of this Notice, Petitioner states:

1. On 4/26/2026, Petitioner filed a Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus under 28 U.S.C. § 2241 challenging his immigration detention.
2. Petitioner has since been released from custody on his own recognizance by Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE).
