21 to an administrative warrant for his arrest.¹ Nonetheless, Petitioner appears to be a member
22 of the Bond Eligible Class certified in *Maldonado Bautista v. Santacruz*, No. 5:25-CV-
23 01873-SSS-BFM, --- F. Supp. 3d ---, 2025 WL 3288403 (C.D. Cal. Nov. 25, 2025). The
24 Ninth Circuit later stayed application of the Order beyond the Central District of California.
