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**RESPONSE TO ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE**

On May 14, 2026, Petitioner's request for bond was granted by an immigration judge, and he was released from U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement ("ICE") custody on May 19, 2026. Composite Exhibit, pgs. 3 and 5. Accordingly, because Petitioner is no longer in ICE custody, Federal Respondents respectfully request that this Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus be dismissed as moot. *Salmeron-Salmeron v. Spivey*, 926 F.3d 1283, 1289 (11th Cir. 2019) ("As a general rule, a habeas petition presents a live case or controversy only when a petitioner is in custody.").
