**SUPPLEMENT TO THE PRAYER FOR RELIEF IN  
EMERGENCY VERIFIED PETITION FOR BOND HEARING  
UNDER APPLICABLE WRIT OF HABEAS CORPUS**

**PRAYER FOR RELIEF**

**WHEREFORE**, Petitioner prays that this Court grant the following relief:

- 1) Assume Jurisdiction over this matter;
- 2) Grant Petitioner a writ of habeas directing the Respondent to immediately release Petitioner from custody on Recognition or with a bond (without undue delays) and/or under a reasonable condition of supervision or otherwise as the Court deems fit;
- 3) Not to conclude this matter until after Respondents' remedy for release is finalized and parties report to the Court for a final decision and Order of the Court; *and*
- 4) Petitioner prays to <sup>the</sup> Court to Order Respondent to immediately process a 'work authorization' with the expiration not less than two years.<sup>1</sup>

<sup>1</sup> Each time Samadi applies for work authorization just to obtain driver license, his application is held for several months in processing (even when he sends it well in advance of expiration of the existing authorization). By the time he receives his new authorization, his license expires – disabling him from attending the children affairs, placing him at risk of violating the driving privileges granted to him by the state.

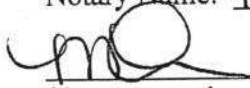
