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**STATUS REPORT**

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Respondents provide this status report per the Court's order, ECF No. 9:

1. In granting the above-captioned habeas petition on May 22, 2026, the Court ordered Respondents to "provide petitioner with a bond hearing under 8 U.S.C. § 1226(a), where the government shall bear the burden of proving that petitioner's continued detention is justified" within seven days of the Order. ECF No. 9 at 4-5. The Court further ordered the parties to "file a status report indicating whether the bond hearing was held and whether bond was granted or denied." ECF No. 9 at 5.<sup>1</sup>

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<sup>1</sup> Undersigned counsel for Respondents attempted to confer with Petitioner's counsel of record regarding this status report in order to file it jointly. 2. A bond hearing under § 1226(a) was held for Petitioner on May 29, 2026. On that date, the Immigration Judge (IJ), recognizing that this Court ordered that the government should bear the burden of proving that Petitioner's continued detention was justified, concluded that Petitioner's ongoing detention was justified because his release would pose a significant risk of flight that could not be mitigated by bond. Accordingly, the IJ denied bond.
