I. INTRODUCTION

Petitioner entered the United States in 2024 and was issued a Notice to Appear. DHS initially released him on his own recognizance. Despite this, he is currently detained. He has no criminal history and is not a flight risk. His hearing is scheduled for 2027.

VI. ARGUMENT

Petitioner's continued detention violates the Due Process Clause of the Fifth Amendment. DHS previously determined he was not a danger or flight risk. His re-detention is arbitrary. His hearing is years away, making detention prolonged and unconstitutional.

VII. REQUEST FOR RELIEF

Petitioner requests immediate release or a prompt bond hearing.
