**REPLY TO PETITIONER'S NOTICE OF SUPPLEMENTAL AUTHORITY IN
SUPPORT OF PETITION FOR WRIT OF HABEAS CORPUS**

The government has reviewed Petitioner's supplemental authority, including the recent district court decision in *ICWC v. Noem*, Case No. 2:25-cv-09848-AB-AS (C.D. Cal. May 20, 2026). That decision reinstated certain policies and directives related to beneficiaries of victim-based immigration benefits. Petitioner has a pending U visa, which falls within the scope of the *ICWC* decision.

Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) has been reviewing the *ICWC* decision and actively considering its impact on Petitioner's case (and others similarly situated). The appropriate ICE authorities expect to issue a decision imminently as to whether Petitioner qualifies for release, and the government is therefore hopeful that this litigation will be resolved. We will provide an update on this final decision as soon as it is issued.
