IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. Respondents are directed to file an answer to Petitioner Nabijon N.'s Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus (ECF No. 1) on or before **Tuesday, May 12, 2026**, certifying the true cause and proper duration of Nabijon N.'s confinement and showing cause why the writ should not issue in this case;
2. Respondents' answer must include:
 - a. Such affidavits and exhibits as are needed to establish the lawfulness and correct duration of Nabijon N.'s detention in light of the issues raised in his Petition;

- b. A reasoned memorandum of law and fact explaining Respondents' legal position on Nabijon N.'s claims; and
 - c. Respondents' recommendation on whether an evidentiary hearing should be conducted;
- 3. If Nabijon N. intends to file a reply to Respondents' answer, he must do so on or before **Tuesday, May 19, 2026**;
 - 4. No further submissions from the parties will be permitted except as authorized by Court order; and
 - 5. Respondents are **ORDERED** not to move Nabijon N. outside of the District of Minnesota during the pendency of these proceedings, so that Nabijon N. may consult with his counsel and participate in this litigation while the Court considers his Petition.
