PETITIONER WAS PREVIOUSLY RELEASED UNDER AN "OSUP" AFTER DEMONSTRATING COMPLIANCE OVER AN EXTENDED PERIOD. FOLLOWING RELEASE FROM CRIMINAL CUSTODY, ICE REDETAINED PETITIONER BUT FAILED TO REVOKE THE EXISTING "OSUP." UNDER THE ACCORD DOCTRINE, FEDERAL AGENCIES MUST FOLLOW THEIR OWN REGULATIONS. DETAINING PETITIONER WHILE THE "OSUP" REMAINS IN EFFECT AND WITHOUT PROPER REVOCATION RENDERS THE DETENTION UNLAWFUL.

ICE REDETAINED PETITIONER IMMEDIATELY UPON RELEASE FROM CRIMINAL CUSTODY ON 2-27-2026. CONTINUE DETENTION MUST STILL COMPLY WITH CONSTITUTIONAL LIMITS. DETENTION IS ONLY PERMITTED FOR A PERIOD REASONABLY NECESSARY TO EFFECT REMOVAL PERIOD, WHERE REMOVAL IS NOT LIKELY IN THE FORESEEABLE FUTURE, CONTINUE DETENTION VIOLATES DUE PROCESS.
