**FEDERAL RESPONDENTS' RESPONSE TO PETITIONER'S
EMERGENCY MOTION TO ENFORCE ORDER GRANTING
HABEAS CORPUS AND FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE**

Respondents respond to Petitioner Jesus Eligio Acevedo's motion to enforce order granting release and for immediate release (Doc. 11) as follows:

On May 28, 2026, this Court granted Petitioner's habeas petition and ordered that "[w]ithin seven days of this Order, Respondents shall either afford Petitioner an individualized bond hearing consistent with 8 U.S.C. § 1226(a) or release Petitioner." Doc. 8. The seventh day was yesterday, June 4, 2026.

The undersigned first learned of the Court's order earlier this morning when he saw Petitioner's motion to enforce the Court's order.
