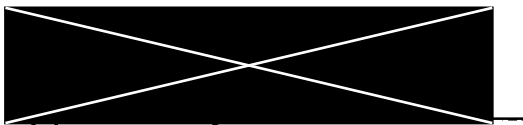

NOTICE TO THE COURT

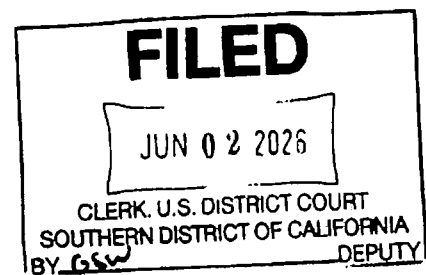
I would like to notify the court, that since my order from The District Court by The Honorable Judge Andrew G. Schopler dated on May 11th, 2026, I have yet to be given a custody determination or bond hearing. My petition was granted by the district judge and ordered the immigration court to provide me with a fair bond hearing where the government (DHS,) bears the burden of proof with clear and convincing evidence that I pose a danger or flight risk.

Furthermore, the district court also specifically noted that I where to receive this bond hearing on or before May 25th, 2026, which until this day has not happened. Therefore I respectfully ask the court to verify and fact check in order to grant my motion to enforce in which I respectfully ask the court to order my immediate release for the government's failure to provide me with a fair bond hearing and not complying with the court order by The Honorable Judge Andrew G. Schopler.

**ORDER GRANTING HABEAS
PETITION (ECF 1) AND ORDERING
BOND HEARING**

Petitioner Alberto Villa seeks a writ of habeas corpus under 28 U.S.C. § 2241 challenging his immigration detention. The government “concedes that this Court should order that Petitioner receive a bond hearing, where the government would bear the burden of proof of establishing, by clear and convincing evidence, that Petitioner poses a danger to the community or a risk of flight.” (ECF 8, at 2.) The Court thus **GRANTS** the petition and orders that petitioner receive such a bond hearing by [REDACTED]. All pending deadlines and hearings are vacated, and all pending motions are denied. The Clerk’s Office is directed to issue a judgment and close this case.
