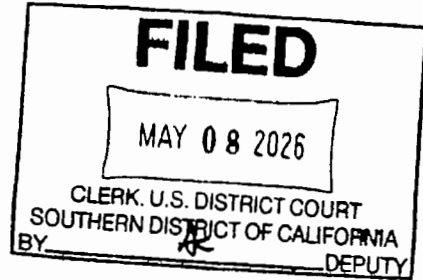

GROUND ONE: My continued detention without a bond hearing violates the Immigration Nationality Act & the 5th Amendment of the Constitution.

(a) Supporting FACTS (state *briefly* without citing cases or law) I was brought into custody while on an evening stroll with my boyfriend in Westmoreland, CA. I was not seeking admission nor am I a recent entrant. I have lived here for nearly 30 years. My parents, whom are both U.S citizens, are both in their 70's. I am their only daughter and I worry for their well being, especially being held against my will in detention. I am a no flight risk. I am fighting a case without any help outside, it is extremely difficult to gather evidence when both of my parents are of old age and they are my only support.
