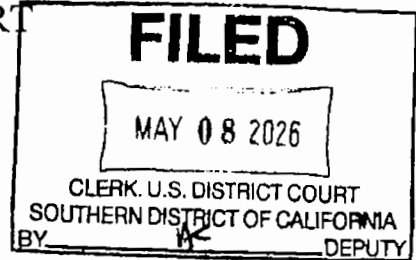

GROUND ONE: I entered the United States in 2023 and was given a parole by the Border Patrol Agents.

I entered the United States with my family on August 28, 2023 and was granted a parole for one year. My family was given an order of release on recognizance the same day. My family was able to obtain social securities and work permits, valid until 2030. In addition my asylum case started in 2024, with USCIS, before reaching the one year mark.

GROUND TWO: Throughout the time, I have in the United States, I started my asylum case with USCIS. Never the less the Honorable Judge, in the Olay Mesa Immigration Court, preterminated my asylum case.

Upon my arrival, in the United States, my family was given an Order of Release on Recognizance. In 2024, I started my asylum process and was ongoing while I lived in Logan, Utah. I arrived to the Olay Mesa Detention Center on January 18, 2026 and on March 4, 2026, the Honorable Judge preterminated my asylum case and gave an order to be sent to a third world country. The Honorable Judge did not present a date for removal. I did not appeal for reason of not having the money for a lawyer.

I also have a fungus problem that came from the dirty showers.
