RESPONDENT'S MOTION TO STRIKE MOTION TO DISMISS OR TRANSFER

Respondent United States Immigration and Customs Enforcement moves to strike its Motion to Dismiss or Transfer this action to the Middle District of Florida.

On April 22, 2026, Respondent moved to dismiss this action or transfer it to the Middle District of Florida based upon Petitioner's representation in the Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus that he was detained in the custody of Immigration and Customs Enforcement at South Florida Detention Center Facility in Ochopee, Florida. *See* Petition at ¶ 2.

After moving to dismiss or transfer this action, however, the undersigned learned from U.S. Customs and Immigration Enforcement that Petitioner had been transferred to Krome Service Processing Center, here in the Southern District of Florida, on April 16, 2026. He was, therefore, detained in this District and was detained here on the date his Petition was filed, April 21, 2026. *See* Petition.

Accordingly, Respondent withdraws and moves to strike its Motion to Dismiss or Transfer.
