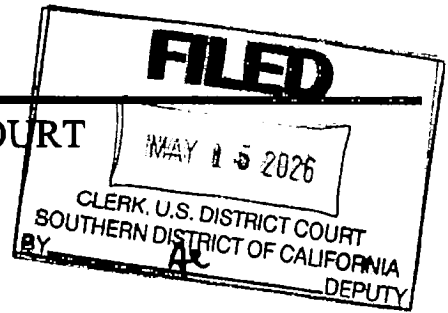

I initially crossed the US border on 09/28/2022 and was released at the discretion of the attorney general on parole on the same day. I have ever since been living in the United States with my family I have never violated the conditions of my release on parole. I was arrested while driving on an highway with my girlfriend. I was pulled over by the police who asked for my identification, he saw that I was paroled into the country he alerted the ICE to arrest me. I have a legal driving license I did not violate any law I do not know why I was arrested.

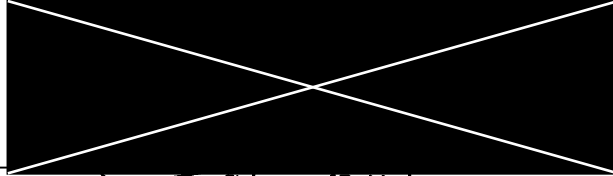
