PETITION FOR WRIT OF HABEAS CORPUS

TO THE HONORABLE COURT:

I, Juan Jose Carcamo Gonzalez, respectfully submit this Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2241, challenging my continued detention by immigration authorities.

I. JURISDICTION

This Court has jurisdiction under 28 U.S.C. § 2241 because I am currently in custody in violation of the Constitution and laws of the United States.

II. CUSTODY STATUS

I am currently detained by Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) at Stewart Detention Center.

My detention has continued for a prolonged period of time without a meaningful opportunity for release.

III. FACTUAL BACKGROUND

I am a citizen of El Salvador. I have been living in the United States for several years.

I am the father of three minor children who are all United States citizens. One of my children is an infant under one year of age.

My children are currently in the United States without the presence of either parent. Their mother is not currently present in the United States.

I was detained following a domestic incident in which both my spouse and I were arrested.

IV. PROLONGED DETENTION IN VIOLATION OF DUE PROCESS

My continued detention violates my constitutional right to due process under the Fifth Amendment.

Under *Zadvydas v. Davis*, immigration detention cannot be indefinite. Prolonged detention without sufficient justification raises serious constitutional concerns.

I have remained in custody for an extended period of time without a meaningful opportunity to obtain release.

V. LACK OF MEANINGFUL REVIEW

My request for bond was denied, and I have not been provided with a meaningful opportunity to challenge my continued detention.

This lack of meaningful review violates due process protections.

VI. HUMANITARIAN FACTORS

My continued detention is causing severe hardship to my three United States citizen children.

My children are currently without the presence of either parent. One of them is an infant who requires daily care and supervision.

I am the only parent available to provide support and care for my children.

VII. REQUEST FOR RELIEF

WHEREFORE, I respectfully request that this Court:

1. Grant this Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus;
2. Order my immediate release from detention;
